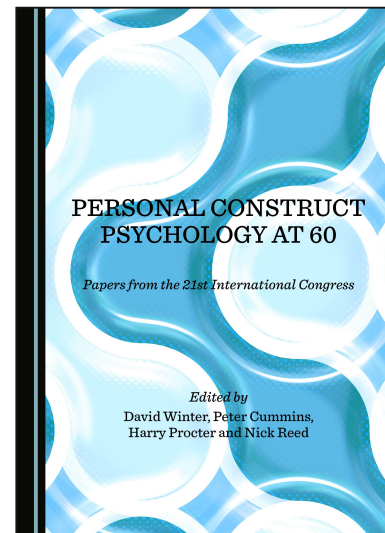
The 21st International Congress was held in the UK at the University of Hertfordshire, forty years after the first such congress. This volume presents contributions by many of the Congress's delegates, whose chapters reflect the diversity of contemporary applications of personal construct psychology, and the continuing relevance and vitality of Kelly's ideas and methods.

**David Winter** is Professor Emeritus of Clinical Psychology at the University of Hertfordshire, UK. He spent most of his working life practicing as a clinical psychologist and personal construct psychotherapist in the English National Health Service.

**Peter Cummins** is a clinical psychologist who qualified as a personal construct psychotherapist in 1988, at the Centre for Personal Construct Psychology, United Kingdom. He retired from the National Health Service in 2010 after 34 years of clinical practice.

**Harry Procter** is a clinical psychologist and Visiting Professor at the University of Hertfordshire, UK. He has published over 50 papers and chapters covering many topics.

**Nick Reed** is Director of the Centre for Personal Construct Psychology at the University of Hertfordshire, and he led the organization of the 2015 International Congress on Personal Construct Psychology.
